## NEW ENGLAND COLLEGIATE CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### MEN'S BASKETBALL



**PLAYER OF THE WEEK** – Daniel Webster College sophomore guard **Chris Hanson** (Salem, Mass.) was named NECC Player of the Week for the second straight week. He led the Eagles to a 2-0 week including an 80-76 conference win over Mitchell. Hanson averaged 26.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game. In an 89-82 victory over Eastern Nazarene, he shot 77 % from the field and a perfect 100 % from behind the arc nailing 5-of-5. For the week, Hanson shot 60% (19-of-32) from the field, 56% (9-of-16) from the arc and 67% (6-of-9) from the charity stripe.



**ROOKIE OF THE WEEK** – Southern Vermont College freshman guard **Jaret Falkowitz** (Scotia, N.Y.) led the Mountaineers in a tough 80-75 NECC loss to Wheelock. Falkowitz returned to the court after sitting most of the first semester due to injury. He amassed 21 points, four rebounds, five assists and one steal. Falkowitz shot 64% (7-of-11) from the field, 50% (1-of-2) from the arc and 75% (6-of-8) from the line.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK** – Mitchell College junior guard **Jen Iglesias** (Waterbury, Conn.) led the Mariners to their first NECC win, defeating Daniel Webster 84-74. Iglesias lit up the court, scoring 31 points while pulling down seven boards and dishing out six assists. She shot 57% (8-of-14) from the field, 43% (3-of-7) from downtown and 80% (12-of-15) from the charity stripe.



**ROOKIE OF THE WEEK** - Elms College freshman guard **Carolyn Talmadge** (Wilbraham, Mass.), for the second straight week, was named NECC player of the week. Talmadge averaged 13.5 points per game, 6.5 rebounds, 6.5 assists and 1.5 steals per game.
